If you would like to send us a **Video** or **Audio** application, here are our guidelines:

In your video or audio, please tell us about yourself and why you would like to join ESAS, using the guided questions below as prompts:

- **Motivation** Why would you like to join the ESAS Board?
- **Alignment** How do your values and experiences align with ESAS's mission to advocate for East and Southeast Asian (ESEA) communities in Scotland and the UK?
- **Experience & Skills** What skills, professional expertise or perspectives do you bring (e.g. finance, governance, fundraising, HR, policy, human rights, or community organising)?
- **Time Commitment** This is an unpaid voluntary role (reasonable expenses reimbursed). Are you able to commit approximately 29 hours per year that includes:
 - Ongoing quarterly online Board meetings and contributions to Board governance throughout the year.
 - An annual in-person Board meeting in Scotland (end of year).
 - Every 5 years, a Governance Development Weekend (the first will be in Nov/Dec 2025 as part of our 5-year capacity-building cycle).
- **Practicalities** Are you currently based in Scotland or elsewhere in the UK, and able to attend at least one in-person meeting in Scotland each year?
